Assignment 1: Tuesday

Form groups of about 6 people (half Dutch and half Italian)

Assignment: What if our schools were countries....what would our heritage be?

Look up things connected with your school which would be worth preserving. Think of a special classroom, a work of art and so on. Go around the CCC to find things and try to find something similar at the Italian school (you could even ask your friends to send you a photo of it) Come back to the classroom and have your thing written down by Ms Bertram because no two groups can choose the same thing. Make a poster of it writing down why this thing is worth preserving. Prepare a poster presentation for Monday

Assignment 2 Tuesday and Thursday

Form groups of about 8 people (half Dutch and half Italian)

Assignment: make a film

You can choose from (each one can be chosen only once so have your choice written down by Ms Bertram))

- An ancient Roman meets an ancient Dutch man – a comical sketch
- Our generation's heritage (songs, movies, art, etc)
- A comparison of Amsterdam and Rome
- Famous Dutch art from the Golden Age becomes alive
- A comparison of the Italians and the Dutch – a comical sketch
- Prejudices about the Dutch and the Italians
- The ancient Dutch (food, houses, clothing etc)
- The exchange (both in Rome and in Zwolle) – an impression
- Why we should be proud of our country's heritage

Discuss on Tuesday what you are going to do and make the film on Thursday morning. You can shoot scenes at the Open Air Museum if you want. You show the film on Monday to the group.
